Lyophilized from nanodisc solubilization buffer (20 mM Tris-HCl, 150 mM NaCl, pH 8.0). Normally 5% Formulation & - 8% trehalose is added as protectants before lyophilization. Please see Certificate of Analysis Reconstitution for specific instructions. Do not use solvents with

pH lower than 6.5 in subsequent experiments. Store at -20°C to -80°C for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not

intended for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80°C (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing). Lyophilized proteins are shipped at ambient

temperature.

The protein is a member of the beta chemokine receptor family, which is predicted to be a seven transmembrane protein similar to G proteincoupled receptors. The gene is preferentially expressed by immature dendritic cells and memory T cells. The ligand of this receptor is macrophage inflammatory protein 3 alpha (MIP-3

alpha). This receptor has been shown to be important for B-lineage maturation and antigendriven B-cell differentiation, and it may regulate the migration and recruitment of dentritic and T cells during inflammatory and immunological responses. Alternatively spliced transcript variants that encode the same protein have been
